

Privacy Notice for the Processing of Personal Data.  
Articles 13 and 14 of EUROPEAN REGULATION No. 679/2016  
Legislative Decree 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018

Dear Data Subject,

Calicantus Srl, as the Data Controller, informs you pursuant to Article 13 of the European Regulation No. 679/2016 (hereafter "EU Regulation") that your data, collected during your navigation on this website, will be processed as follows:

#### Data Controller

The Data Controller is Calicantus Srl, located at Via L. Mazzon, 28/30 - 30020 Quarto d'Altino (VE), Tax Code and VAT No. 03757590272, (hereafter "Controller" and/or "Seller").

#### Categories of Processed Data and Sources of Origin

Browsing data (the computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, in their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This category of data includes: IP addresses, the type of browser used, the operating system, the domain name and addresses of websites from which access or exit was made, information on pages visited by users within the site, access time, stay on the single page, internal path analysis, and other parameters related to the user's operating system and computer environment. Such technical/information technology data are collected and used exclusively in an aggregated and anonymous form. These data are processed to allow and control correct usage of this site and to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site, and are deleted immediately after processing)

Data voluntarily provided by the user, including:

Common data such as, for example, personal and contact details (e.g., purchaser's name, email; delivery address, phone, etc.);

Data related to payment methods (last 4 digits of the credit card and transaction ID);

Data related to orders placed.

#### Purpose of Processing

The personal data of the Website Users, as described above, will be processed in the manner and form prescribed by the GDPR.

Specifically, the personal data provided to the Controller will be processed for the following purposes:

Fulfillment of obligations arising from the online purchase contract made by the consumer through the e-Commerce Site;

Obligations related to such a contract (e.g., administrative, accounting, tax) - protection in case of disputes; Customer service management; - Preservation of personal data, if provided by the existing Relationship;

Any other purpose related to the performance of the services subject of the Relationship between the parties;

Execution of contractual/legal obligations arising from the distance sale concluded with the consumer.

#### Legal Basis for Processing

The processing of personal data is based on the fulfillment of contractual or pre-contractual obligations (Art. 6(1)(b) EU Regulation), related to the User's request, and/or to comply with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject (Art. 6(1)(c) EU Regulation).

It is specified that filling in specific fields provided in forms for requesting information is related to the request itself and therefore involves fulfilling a pre-contractual or contractual obligation, depending on the context. Consent may be subsequently requested for the processing of additional data.

A specific privacy notice will be provided wherever necessary (different from this one).

The processing is also based on legitimate interest (Art. 6(1)(f) recitals 47, 48, 113 EU Regulation), including the right to information, to which reference is made in the following paragraph.

#### Legitimate Interest of the Controller

The processing of personal data is also based on the legitimate interest of the Controller, such as exercising their rights in the context of the information society and the execution of the contractual performance.

#### Necessity of Providing Data

Except for navigation data, necessary for implementing IT and telematic protocols, the provision of Data by users is free and optional. However, failure to provide such Data will result in the impossibility of proceeding with the requests submitted or intended to be submitted by the user.

#### Possible Recipients of Personal Data, Processing Methods, and Existence of Automated Decision-Making, Including Profiling

Data may be communicated to companies related, linked, or controlled by the Controller, as well as to consultants, or even to third parties operating, also on behalf of the Controller, for the fulfillment of services connected to the purposes indicated in this notice.

In any case, data may be communicated to Processors, as well as to persons authorized to process data and duly trained, always within the scope of the purposes of the processing.

Your personal data will not be disclosed and will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations, and will not be communicated to third parties except for legal or contractual obligations (it is specified that contractual obligations also include the communication of data to other Companies directly connected to the Writer, being the activities of these essential to the completion/execution of what you have requested).

Regarding the provisions of Art. 13 of the EU Regulation paragraph 2 letter f) and Art. 14 of the EU Regulation paragraph 2 letter g) it is noted that the Controller currently does not use any automated decision-making system or process.

#### Retention Period

The data voluntarily provided by the Interested Party will be stored for a period not exceeding that strictly necessary for the fulfillment of legal and contractual obligations or until the express withdrawal by the Interested Party. Navigation data will be stored, in compliance with the principle of proportionality, in a form that allows the identification of the Interested Party for a period of time not exceeding that necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed.

Excluded from the above terms are cases where it is necessary to keep the data for a longer period to defend or assert a right or to fulfill any legal obligations or orders of the Authorities.

#### Rights of the Interested Party

Each Interested Party has the right of access, rectification, deletion (right to be forgotten), limitation, notification in case of rectification, deletion or limitation, portability, opposition, and not to be subject to an individual automated decision, including profiling, according to Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR. These rights can be exercised in the forms and terms provided for in Article 12 GDPR, by written communication sent to the Controller (see point 10).

#### Right to Withdraw Consent (How to Exercise Rights)

Consent, where provided, can be revoked at any time and/or exercise your rights by sending:

a registered letter with acknowledgment of receipt to the undersigned with an explicit request (see the address indicated on the letterhead);

## Complaints

Each Interested Party has the right to lodge a complaint under Articles 77 and following of the GDPR to a supervisory authority, which for Italy is identified in the Italian Data Protection Authority. The complaint does not affect administrative and jurisdictional actions, which in Italy can alternatively be proposed to the same Authority or to the competent Court.
